DAY THREE ETERNAL APPOINTMENT

We must all stand before the same *Jesus Christ* and give an account for our lives. Yes, all of us have an eternal appointment at the court of the *King of Kings!*

How do we know? Our precious brother Paul told us in verse ten of chapter five of his second letter to Corinth:

“For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ; that every one may receive the things done in his body, according to that he hath done, whether it be good or bad.”

(2 Corinthians 5:10 KJV)

This appointment was scheduled long ago for each of us; you see, this is an *eternal appointment*. Unlike our appointments in time, this one cannot be scheduled by us, canceled, or rescheduled by us!

This will not end with any follow-ups or prescriptions written, and most importantly, we shall not be late.

For shortly after the hour in which the *Son of God* calls all to rise, each one of us will have to stand before Him and answer for our lives. Now the question is: what will He be like?

DAY FOUR ETERNAL APPOINTMENT

“For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ; that every one may receive the things done in his body, according to that he hath done, whether it be good or bad.”

2. Read (Romans 14:10 KJV)

"But why dost thou judge thy brother? or why dost thou set at nought thy brother? for we shall all stand before the judgment seat of Christ."

(Romans 14:10 KJV)

3. How does the thought of facing the Son of God make you feel?

4. If you were to be cut off today, are you prepared for your eternal appointment?

5. Envision in your mind our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ! What does He look like?

After all have risen, all shall head toward their *eternal appointment with the* final judge! As we approach His judgment seat, many will realize that they got Him wrong.

The Christ that will be standing across from all of us will not look like any of the blasphemous, graven images that we have all seen! Every image that has been made of *our Christ* has been made to deceive us!

However you imagine the *King of Kings* looking, He will not look like that. So, the question remains: how will He look and what will He be like?

Let's turn to *our Lord's* Revelation and see how the precious disciple John describes *our Lord*:

“His head and his hairs were white like wool, as white as snow; and his eyes were as a flame of fire; And his feet like unto fine brass, as if they burned in a furnace; and his voice as the sound of many waters. And he had in his right hand seven stars: and out of his mouth went a sharp two edged sword: and his countenance was as the sun shineth in his strength.”
(Revelation 1:14-16 KJV)

This is what the *Lord of Lords* will look like! Where does it say that He will have “flowing” hair, “welcoming” eyes, or an outstretched hand?

You will not find any of those descriptions of *our Christ* in the *Word of God*. Why? Because *the Lord of Lords* does not look like that. And at the sight of Him, each and every one of us will be terrified. How do we know? The precious disciple John told us.

John, the disciple who knew *our Lord* very well, had the opportunity to see *our Christ* in His true form, and at the sight of *our Lord*, John fell to His feet as dead.

“And when I saw him, I fell at his feet as dead. And he laid his right hand upon me, saying unto me, Fear not; I am the first and the last”
(Revelation 1:17 KJV)

I am here to remind you that this is the same *Jesus Christ* who will be across from us waiting to pass judgment on our lives.

And when we see His eyes as a flaming fire and Him shining as the sun in its strength, we shall fall to His feet as dead!

1. Read (Revelation 1:14-16 KJV)

"His head and his hairs were white like wool, as white as snow; and his eyes were as a flame of fire; And his feet like unto fine brass, as if they burned in a furnace; and his voice as the sound of many waters. And he had in his right hand seven stars: and out of his mouth went a sharp twoedged sword: and his countenance was as the sun shineth in his strength."

(Revelation 1:14-16 KJV)

2. Read (Isaiah 53 KJV)(see next page for text)

3. As you see there is a different picture of our Lord in the Word of God! Compare and contrast with the description that you recorded in question five of *Day Four*.

(Isaiah 53 KJV)

- 1 Who hath believed our report? and to whom is the arm of the Lord revealed?
- 2 For he shall grow up before him as a tender plant, and as a root out of a dry ground: he hath no form nor comeliness; and when we shall see him, there is no beauty that we should desire him.
- 3 He is despised and rejected of men; a man of sorrows, and acquainted with grief: and we hid as it were our faces from him; he was despised, and we esteemed him not.
- 4 Surely he hath borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows: yet we did esteem him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted.
- 5 But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed.
- 6 All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned every one to his own way; and the Lord hath laid on him the iniquity of us all.
- 7 He was oppressed, and he was afflicted, yet he opened not his mouth: he is brought as a lamb to the slaughter, and as a sheep before her shearers is dumb, so he openeth not his mouth.
- 8 He was taken from prison and from judgment: and who shall declare his generation? for he was cut off out of the land of the living: for the transgression of my people was he stricken.
- 9 And he made his grave with the wicked, and with the rich in his death; because he had done no violence, neither was any deceit in his mouth.
- 10 Yet it pleased the Lord to bruise him; he hath put him to grief: when thou shalt make his soul an offering for sin, he shall see his seed, he shall prolong his days, and the pleasure of the Lord shall prosper in his hand.
- 11 He shall see of the travail of his soul, and shall be satisfied: by his knowledge shall my righteous servant justify many; for he shall bear their iniquities.
- 12 Therefore will I divide him a portion with the great, and he shall divide the spoil with the strong; because he hath poured out his soul unto death: and he was numbered with the transgressors; and he bare the sin of many, and made intercession for the transgressors.

DAY SEVEN WILL YOU BE READY?

As you stand before the *Judgment Seat of Christ*, will you be ready to answer for your life? Until now, you may have believed that there is no judgment or no one that you will have to answer to for the way that you have lived your life.

By now, you know that this is not true! For as our scripture tells us, we shall all stand before *the Judgment Seat of Christ* and give an account for the deeds done in the body.

“For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ; that every one may receive the things done in his body, according to that he hath done, whether it be good or bad.”

(2 Corinthians 5:10 KJV)

Now that you are aware of your eternal fate, the question remains: will you be ready? Will you be ready to stand before millions and billions and answer for your life?

Will you be ready to watch as your life is displayed? And yes, that includes every secret thing. For as our scripture tells us, *our Lord* will bring everything into judgment including every secret thing!

DAY SEVEN WILL YOU BE READY?

"For God shall bring every work into judgment, with every secret thing, whether it be good, or whether it be evil."

(Ecclesiastes 12:14 KJV)

Will you be ready to answer to the *Lord of Lords* and the *King of Kings*, knowing that He is the FINAL judge? And as the final judge, His judgment is true and just as *our Lord* states in His Gospel as recorded by John:

"I can of mine own self do nothing: as I hear, I judge: and my judgment is just; because I seek not mine own will, but the will of the Father which hath sent me."

(John 5:30 KJV)

At His voice, all shall rise. At the sight of Him, all shall be paralyzed with fear. Then we shall take our turn standing before Him at His *judgment seat*.

DAY NINE THE JUDGMENT SEAT OF JESUS CHRIST

At the *voice of the Son of God*, all shall rise! At the sight of the *Son of God*, all shall be paralyzed with fear! And all shall stand before His eternal court!

At the *Judgment Seat of Christ*, we shall all stand and give an account for our lives. Before *our Lord*, we shall answer for every action, every idle word spoken, and every deed.

“But I say unto you, That every idle word that men shall speak, they shall give account thereof in the day of judgment.”
(Matthew 12:36 KJV)

Everything that we answer for will be things that we have done. There will be no word that we did not speak, no action that we did not do, and no secret thing that wasn't ours.

There, we will have the chance to answer for our lives. As *our Lord* says in His *gospel*: as He hears, He judges!

Again, we do not see that there are any exceptions!
For if we return to our scripture, we again see that
our precious brother Paul said, "All".

"For we must all appear before the judgment
seat of Christ; that every one may receive the
things done in his body, according to that he
hath done, whether it be good or bad."
(2 Corinthians 5:10 KJV)

And remember, our precious brother Paul is writing
to those who believe in *Jesus Christ*! How do we
know? Let's turn to verse twelve of chapter three of
Paul's first letter to Corinth;

"Now if any man build upon this foundation
gold, silver, precious stones, wood, hay,
stubble; Every man's work shall be made
manifest: for the day shall declare it, because it
shall be revealed by fire; and the fire shall try
every man's work of what sort it is."
(1 Corinthians 3:12-13 KJV)

Yes, believer, here Paul is speaking to you. Again,
there will be no exceptions!

I hope that you have found something over the past eighteen days that has blessed your life!

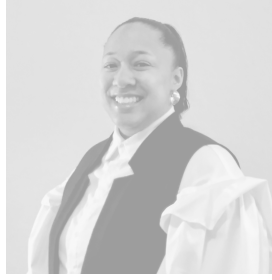
I pray that at this point, you have changed! Whether it is by gaining a personal relationship with our Lord and Savior or by improving your life in Christ.
